- Candidate must be a high school graduate that has received acceptance as a matriculated <u>full</u> <u>time</u> freshman entering an accredited four-year or two-year college or university, a technical or vocational school, or a student who is currently enrolled and matriculated as a <u>full time</u> student in a four year or two year accredited college or university or a technical or vocational school.
- Candidate must have demonstrated academic achievement with a high school minimum cumulative average of 80(C+) or a college minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- High school students must submit an official transcript and a letter of acceptance from the school. College students must submit an official transcript of the prior semester and a bursar receipt for proof of registration for the semester that the scholarship will be applied.
- Candidate must submit three letters of recommendation.
 - 1. A parish society
 - 2. School personnel
 - 3. Personal, other than a family member
- Candidate must submit a personal essay of 250 words typed.
- Candidate must meet with the Scholarship Committee for a personal interview.
- All official documents must be submitted in a sealed envelope along with the application.
- Candidate must submit all required documents by the deadline date for the scholarship committee to consider the application for a scholarship.
